SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be attending one of the Fairbanks area high schools.
2. Applicant must be a graduating senior in the spring of 2011.
3. Applicant must have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 and must submit a **certified sealed transcript**.
4. Applicant must have actively participated in high school-sanctioned cross country or track during the 2010–2011 school year.
5. Applicant must show verification of acceptance to an institution of higher learning, i.e., a vocational school, or a two- or four-year college.
6. Applicant must provide two letters of reference from a coach, counselor, teacher or employer.
7. The application must be filled out completely in order to be considered. Applicants may use additional pages, if necessary. **Please staple additional pages to this application.**
8. Upon notification, the applicant must be present at the 2011 Midnight Sun Run to accept the scholarship. This criteria can be waived for extenuating circumstances.
